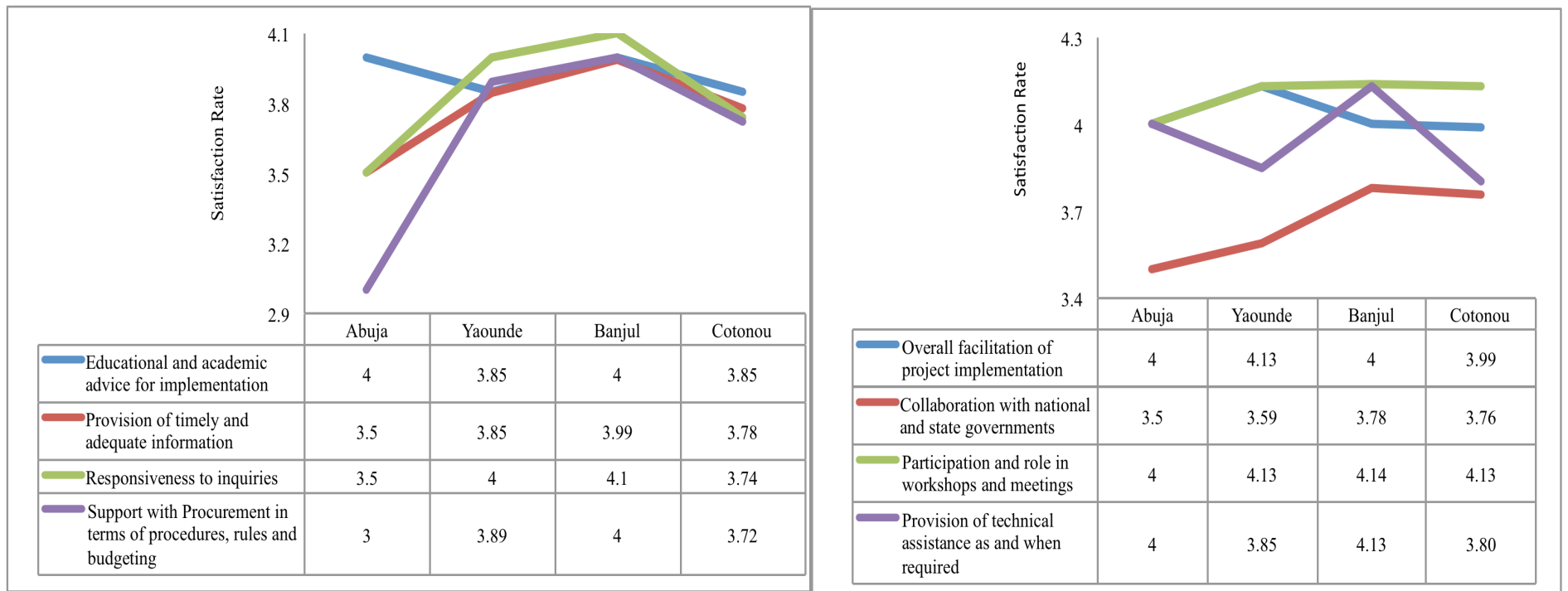


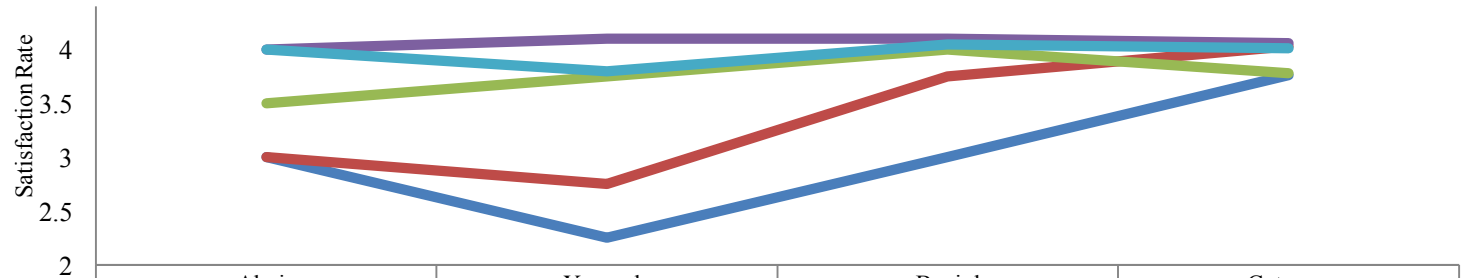
GRAPHICAL SUMMARY OF THE ABUJA, YAOUNDE, BANJUL, and COTONOU WORKSHOPS

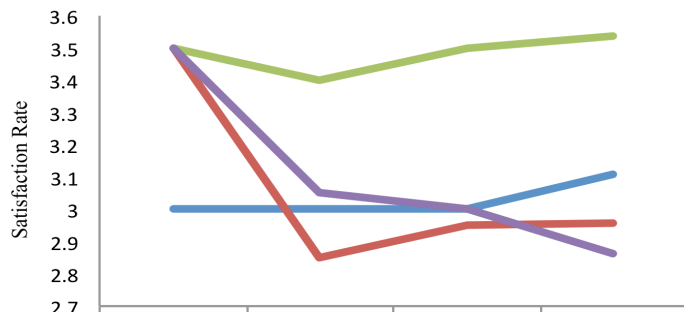

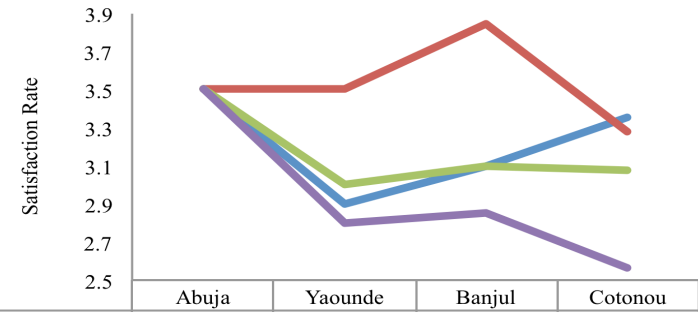

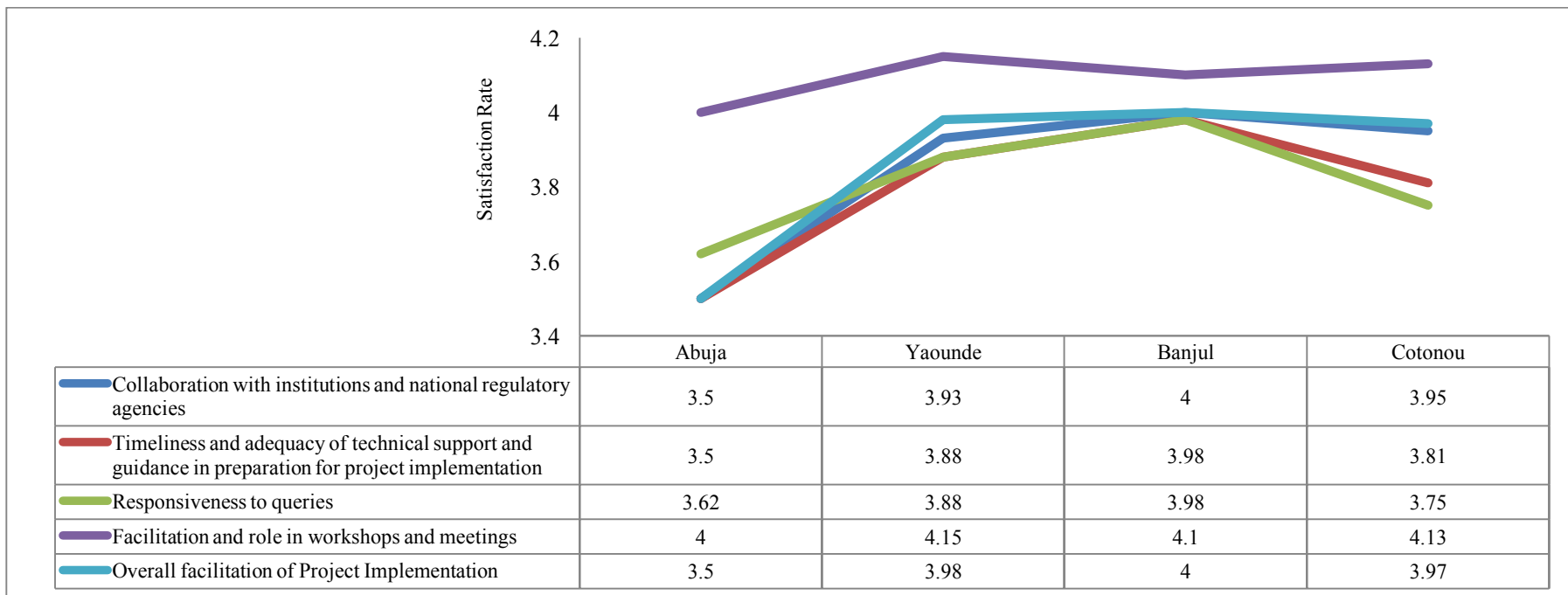
