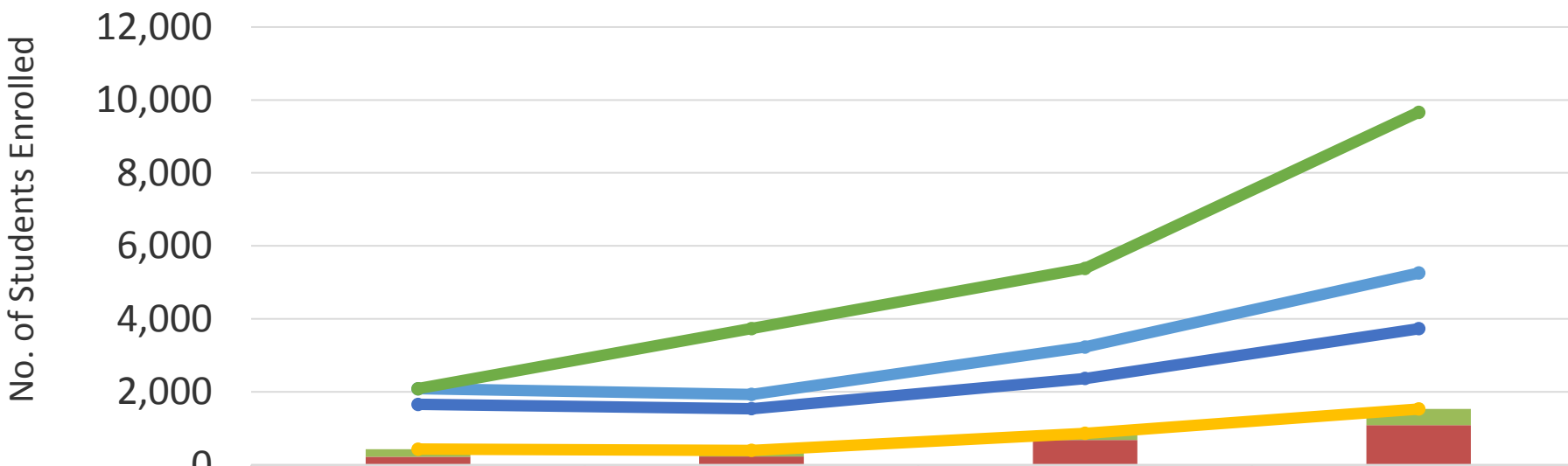

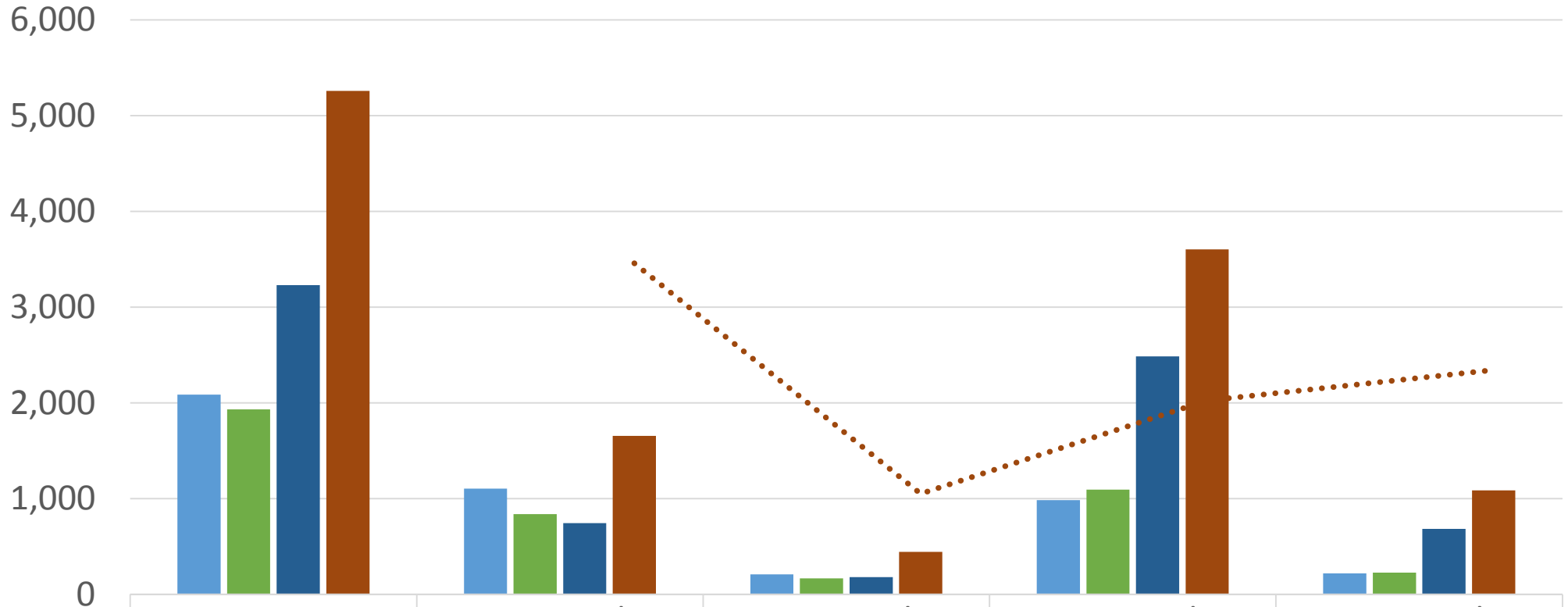

# STUDENT ENROLLMENT BY GENDER



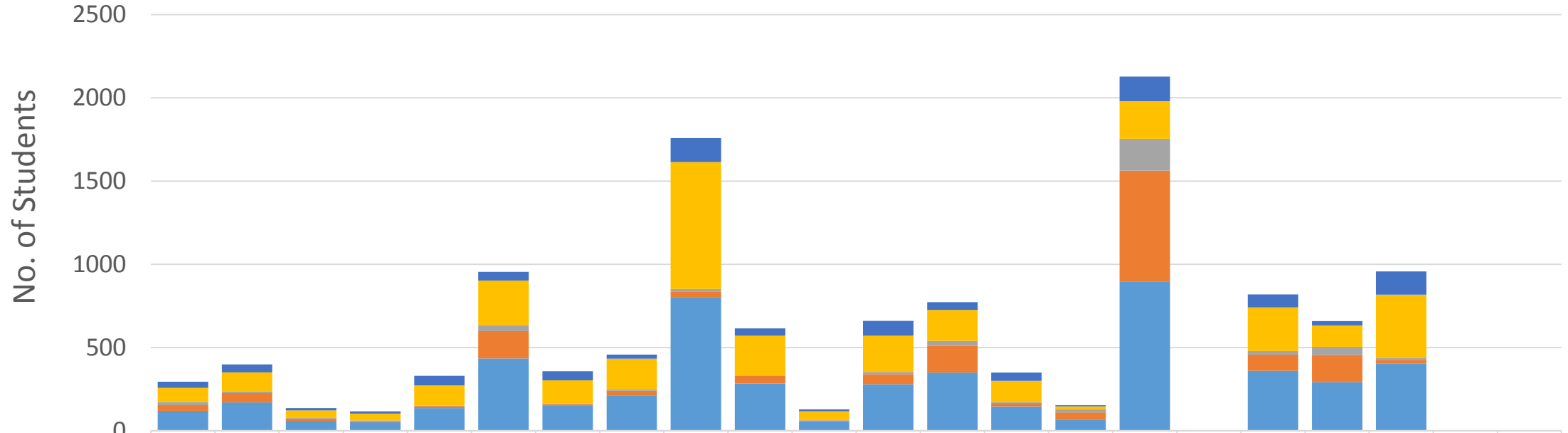

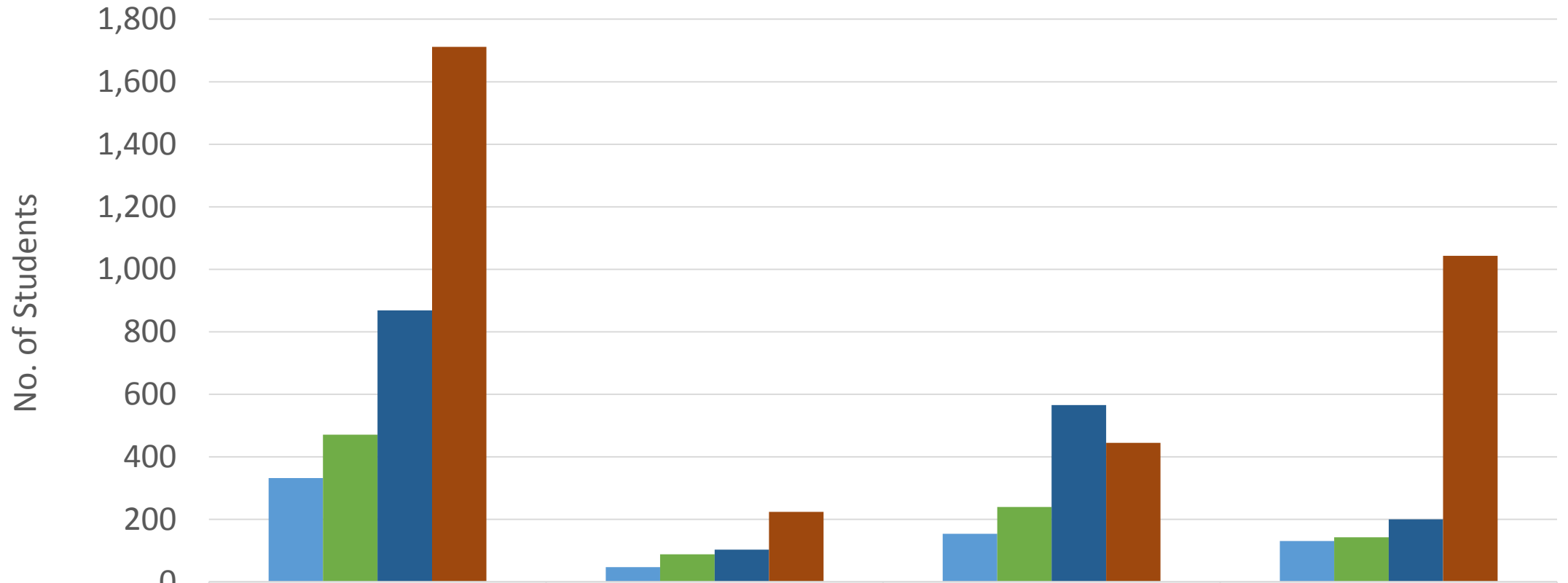

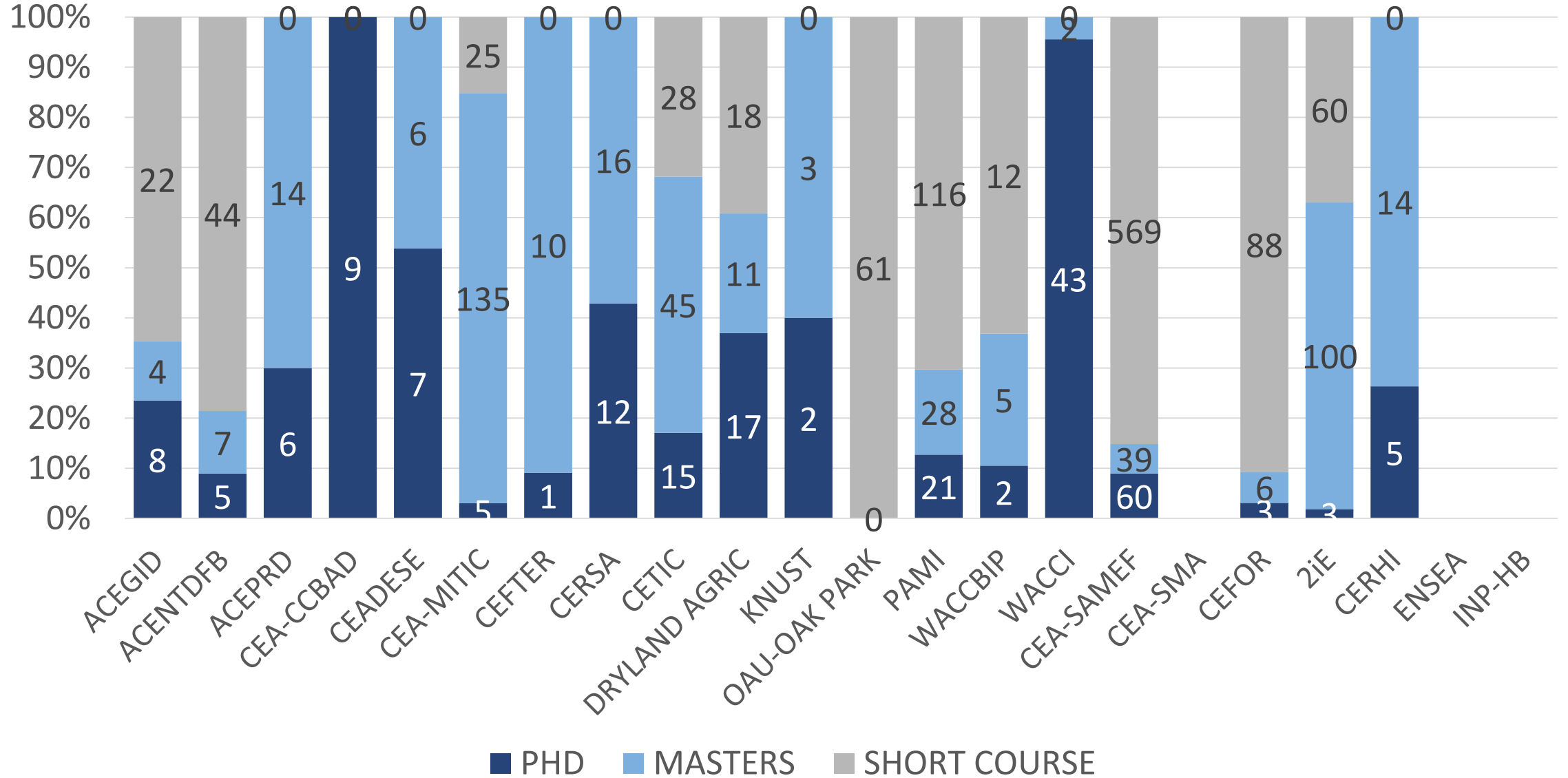

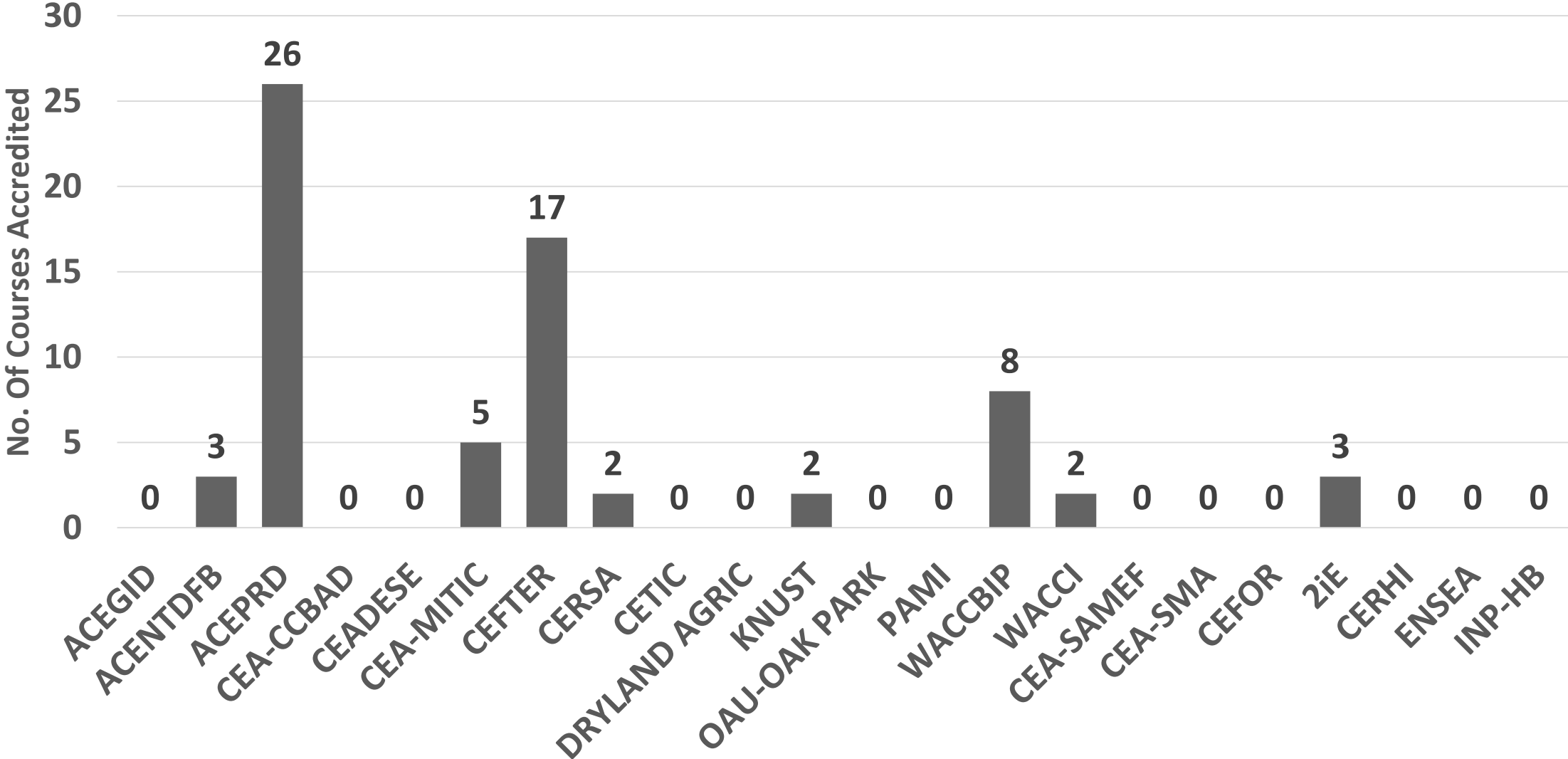

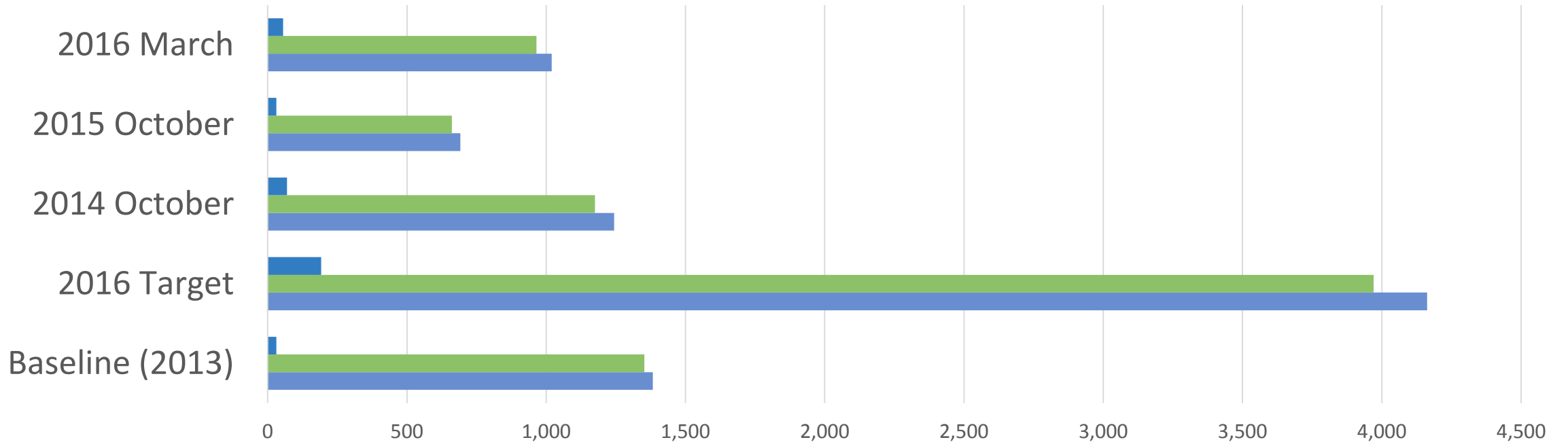
### Regional Students by Course per ACE – MARCH 2016

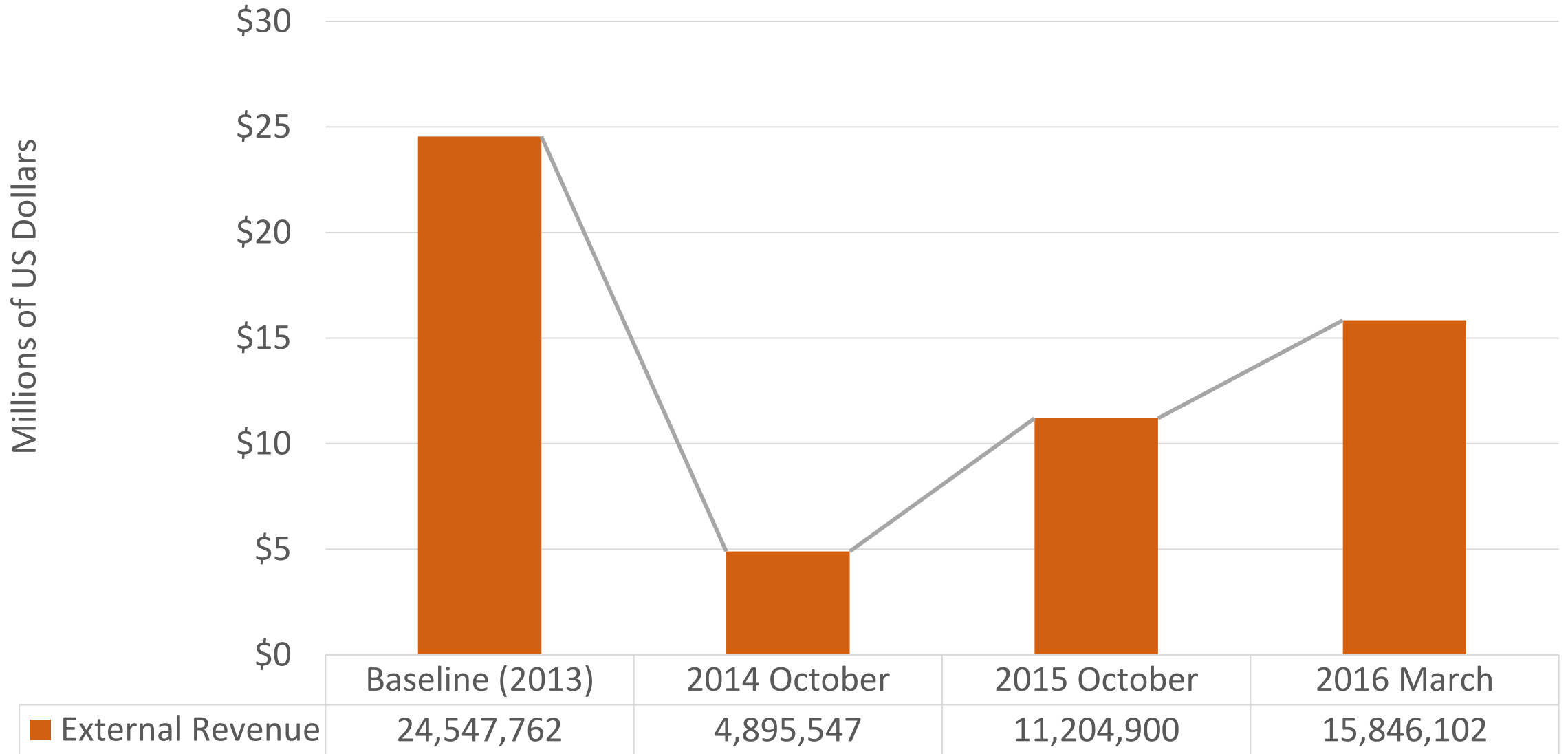

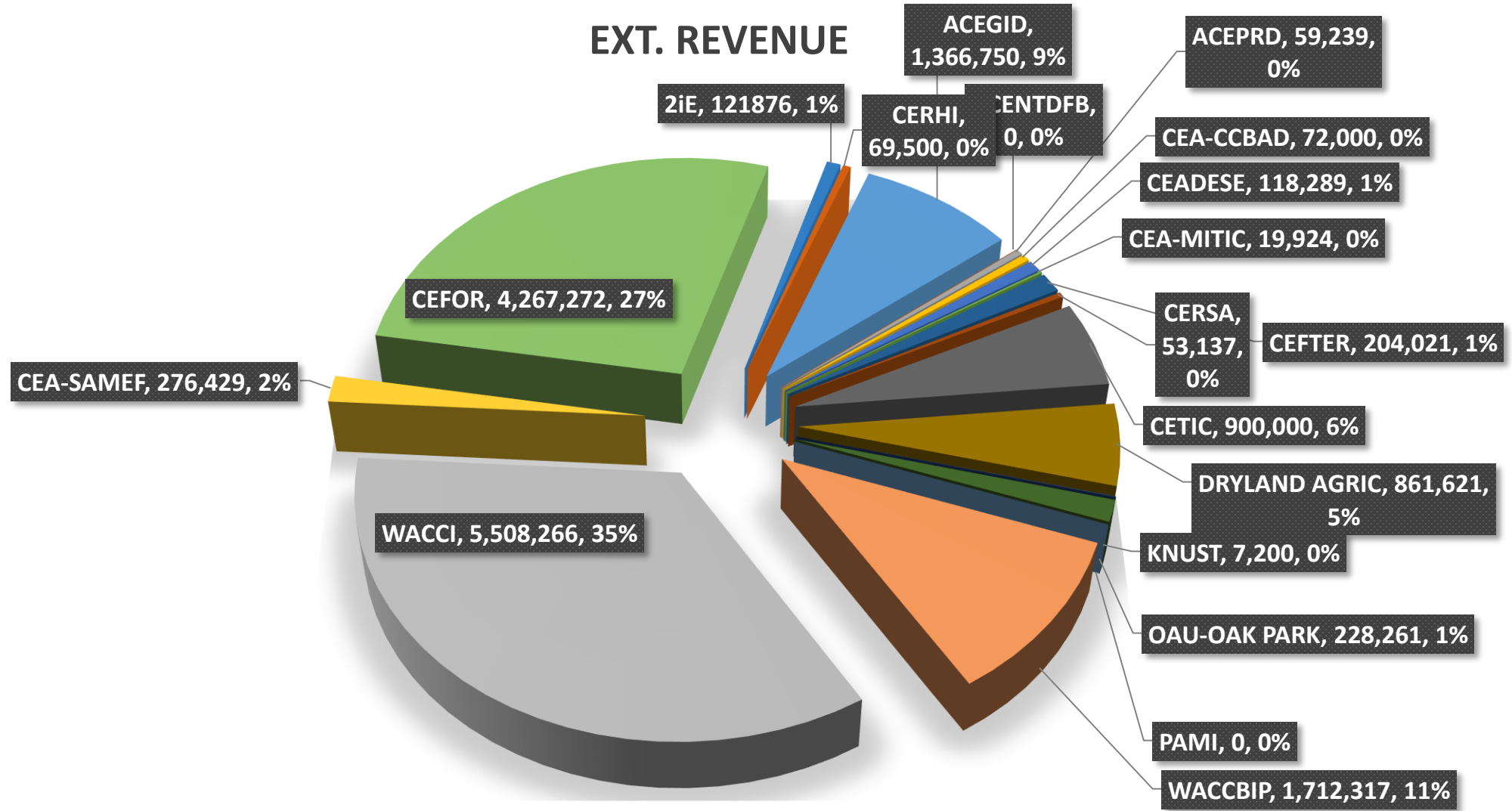

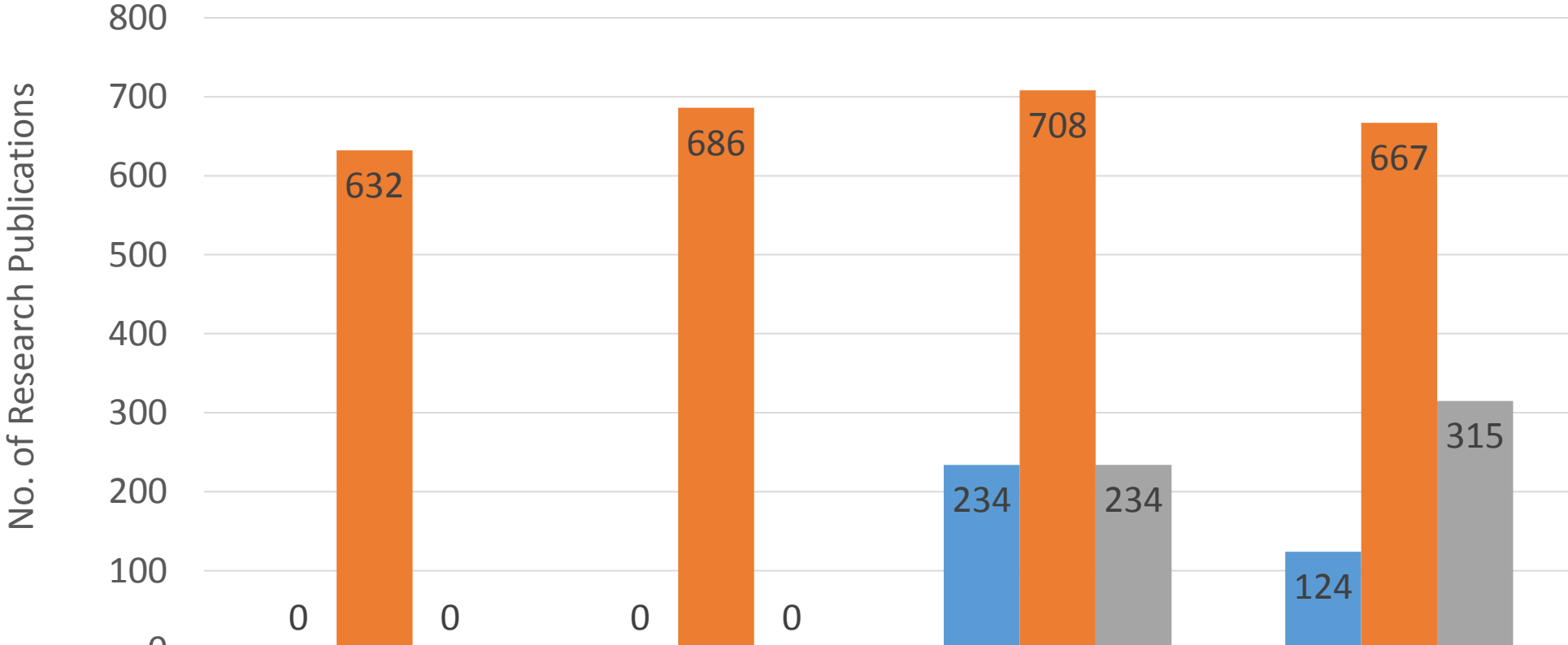
## External Revenue

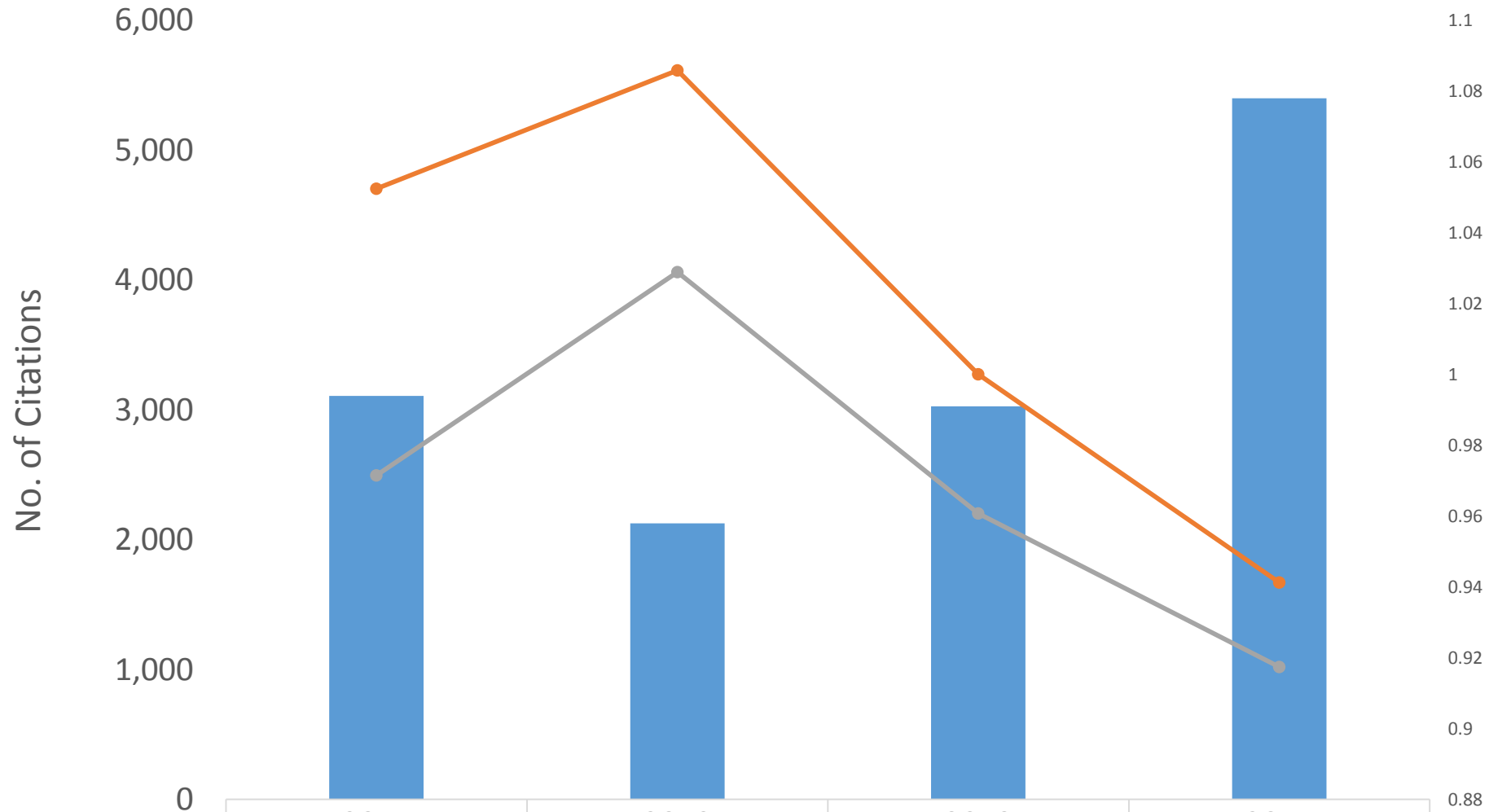
